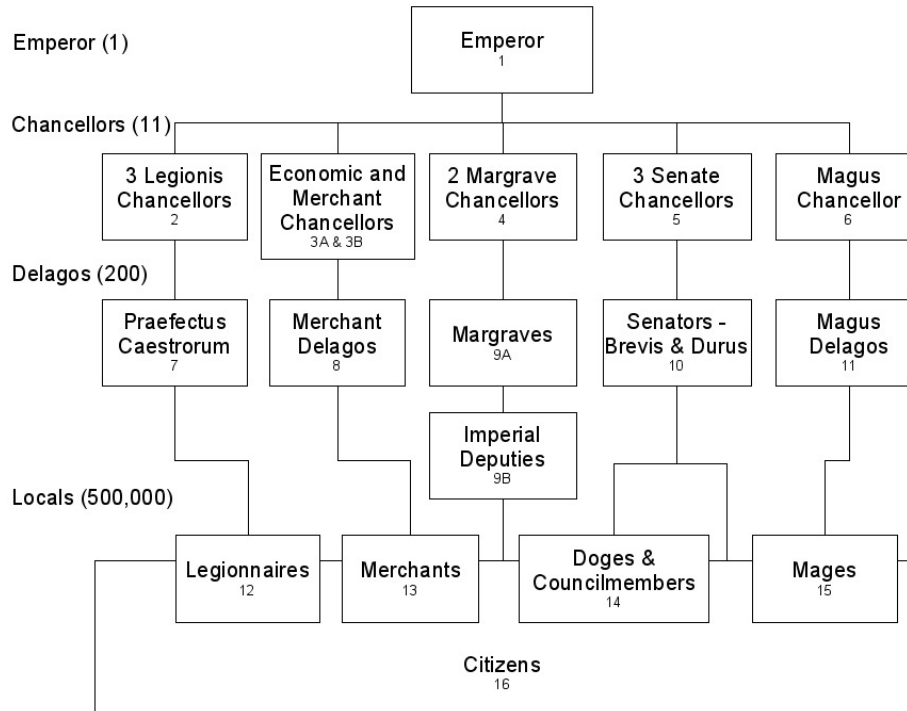


GALERUSIAN GOVERNMENT

NOTES

1. EMPORER

There is only one Emperor
Term is for life or until resignation
Appointed by

current Emperor

Candidates come only from Delagos

When a candidate is appointed, their open position is filled from eligible Delagos

In the event an Emperor dies permanently without naming a successor, the Chancellors will appoint someone from among the Delagos

CHANCELLORS

2. Legionis Chancellor

There are three Legionis Chancellors, one each from the East Army, West Army and Navy

Suggested term is 10 years, no limit on number of times can be appointed

When a candidate is appointed, their open position is filled per current military procedure

3A. Merchant Chancellor

There is only one Merchant Chancellor

Suggested term is 2 years, no limit on number of times can be appointed

Candidates may be selected from the Galerus National Merchant's Council

When a candidate is appointed, their open position is filled from within their merchant guild

3B. Economic Chancellor

There is only one Economic Chancellor

Suggested term is 5 years, no limit on number of times can be appointed

Candidates may be recommended by the Galerus National Merchant's Council or may come from the general populace of citizens

4. Margrave Chancellor

There are two Margrave Chancellors

Suggested terms are 2 years and 5 years, no limit on number of times can be appointed

Candidates may be selected from among the 66 Margraves of all 22 Districts

When a candidate is appointed, their open position is filled via the current Margrave appointment process

5. Senate Chancellor

There are three Senate Chancellors

Suggested term is 3 years, with one appointment each year (in the round)

There is no limit on the number of times can be appointed

Candidates may be selected from the Brevis or Durus Senators

When a candidate is appointed, their open position is filled by special election in their District

6. Magus Chancellor

There is only one Magus Chancellor

Suggested term is 10 years, no limit on number of times can be appointed

Candidates may be selected from the Logopolis Guild Council

When a candidate is appointed, their open position is filled via current Logopolis Guild Council appointment process

DELAGOS

7. Prefect

There are 22 Prefect, one for each District

Term is for life or until resignation

Succession is covered under current military procedure

Candidates come from the Prefect Caestrorum

A Prefect receives concern regarding local matters from the Doge

8. Merchant Delago

There approximately 15 Merchant Delagos, one for each city where there is a Doge

Term is for life or until resignation

Succession is determined within each individual guild

Candidates come from within the vacating merchant's guild

9A. Margrave

There are 66 Margraves, three for each District

Term is for life or until resignation

Margraves are appointed by the Prefect under advisement from the two District Senators

Margrave appointments are temporary until ratified or denied by the two Margrave Chancellors

Candidates come from the ranks of the Imperial Deputies

9B. Imperial Deputies

There are as many Imperial Deputies appointed as a District requires and can support

Term is for life or until resignation

Imperial Deputies are appointed by the Margraves of the District in which they have jurisdiction

Imperial Deputy appointments are temporary until ratified or denied by all three Margraves

Any citizen may be appointed an Imperial Deputy

10. Senator

There are 44 Senators, two for each District

There are two types of Senators, Durus and Brevis

Brevis Senators are elected every two years – no term limit

Durus Senators are elected every ten years – no term limit

There is one Durus and one Brevis Senator for each District

Any citizen may run for Senator

Senators receive counsel on local matters from city Council Members

Where there are citizens in areas without a city council, a Senator receives information regarding local concerns directly from the citizens

11. Magus Delago

There are 22 Magus Delagos, one for each District

Term is for life or until resignation

Magus Delagos are appointed by the Magus Chancellor under advisement from private counsel

Candidates are selected from Guilds associated with the Logopolis

LOCAL

12. Legionnaire

Enlistment, levels, pay, duties, etc. remain as-is

13. Merchant

There is only one merchant's guild allowed per city where there is a Doge

14. Doge

The Doge is appointed by the city's council members. Where a city is not large enough to have elected council members, the Doge is appointed by a panel consisting of the Margraves of the District and the Prefect of the District.

The Doge reports to the Prefect.

Council Member

A city's council members are elected annually. The top five candidates receiving votes are the city's council.

15. Mage

Magic Guild affiliation to the Logopolis is obtained through application to the Logopolis

16. Citizens

Citizens elect Council Members and Senators to represent them in matters of local and national importance

They report local non-legal concerns to a Council Member

Where there are no Council Members they report non-legal concerns to the Doge

Where there is no Doge they report non-legal directly to their Senator

All legal concerns are reported to a Margrave or Imperial Deputy

OTHER

17. Master of Offices

The Master of Offices is appointed by the Prefect of a District to handle administrative and other non-legion related occurrences within the District.

They are to keep archived records of each decision of a Margrave or the Prefect and keep safe all other documentation entrusted to them

18. Praetor

Praetor is a title conferred to those who are members of specific honored orders within the Empire. These orders may be military or civilian, but are always held in high regard, and are to be respected throughout the Empire. The title of Praetor may include land, and men to command.

To become a Praetor, a hopeful must petition to the order they wish to join, or be appointed to the post by a chancellery vote or Imperial Decree.

Each order has a specific mission, and are dedicated to their cause and the Empire completely. The appointment of a Praetor is until their permanent death.
